Late Work and Make-up Work

- 1. Assignments are due as announced on the weekly syllabus. Assignments will not be accepted late, except in the case of an excused absence. If an emergency situation arises and you are not able to complete an assignment, come and talk to me about an emergency extension.
- 2. If you are absent from class for any reason, whether school related or otherwise, YOU ARE REQUIRED to check the class website for changes to the syllabus, watch the vodcasts for any classes you miss, turn in work, and to see me about any additional work missed. Unless it is pre-assigned, you must submit makeup work within one day when absent one day, within two days when absent two days, etc.
 - If you are absent because of school (sports, drama, band, field trip, etc.), you must get your assignments and turn in homework to me **before** you leave. YOU ARE REQUIRED to watch the vodcasts for any classes you miss.
 - If you are absent the day before or the day of a test, you will be expected to take the test the first day you return unless excused by me. If you are absent the day a pre-assigned project is due, you are responsible for seeing that your project is turned in by your class period the day it is due.
- 3. In the case of an unexcused absence, all work (including tests) is due the day you return to school.

Grading Policy

Retesting Policy

Memorization quizzes and chapter test grades below 65 may be eligible for retesting. First, you need make an appointment to correct your original test and arrange for outside tutoring. Then, at my discretion, you will take either the same or a different quiz or retest within one week of receiving your original quiz or test grade. Your grade will be the second score with a maximum score of 65. Usually one chapter test per nine-weeks may be retaken.
