Canvas

- This is like Grand Central Station for all your school stuff – a hub for all of your classes, weekly activities, grades, etc.

Remind.com

- This is a safe way for me to text the entire class with info about due dates, help sessions, project info, etc.
- All students (and/or a parent) must join the class group by texting me at the appropriate number below, and then responding to the next text sent to you with your first and last name. Parents are encouraged to join as well!!
