

Lab Safety Contract Assignment

Since we'll be in lab so much, it's important that you write your own lab safety contract to hold yourself to a high level of responsibility and accountability for safe, proper performance.

Here are the instructions for writing your Lab Safety Contract.

1. Hand write the lab safety statements from the first couple of pages of the **Safety In the Chemistry Classroom** packet as your contract. The Safety packet is the one that you got in class and it's also on the class website under the Lab tab.
2. Write only the first sentence of each statement that is bold, you don't have to write the explanation of each rule. There are 29 in all and they almost all start with "I will...".
3. At the end of your contract – after the last statement, hand write the following statement at the bottom: "I agree to abide by these rules." Then sign underneath and date it.
4. Turn in your assignment by scanning your final signed document as a PDF and then submitting it into your Chemistry Shared Folder. The assignment name is **Lab Safety Contract**. Be sure and scan as a PDF and you can send the PDF straight to your Google Chemistry Shared Folder.
5. **IMPORTANT: You must have this safety contract submitted to be able to participate in lab for the rest of the year!** Check your syllabus for the due date.
